Applicants who have acquired TOEFL iBT 53 or IELTS 5.5 or higher c. N.B No language requirements imposed to the applicants whose native language or second language is English.

3. Selection Criteria

- Successful applicants must meet both of the following;

1) Language proficiency requirements

- ① Applicants who acquired TOPIK (Test of Proficiency in Korean) level 3 or higher
N.B Applicants who are applying for Sports & IT must have TOPIK Level 2 or higher
- ② Applicants who have acquired TOEFL iBT 53 or IELTS 5.5 or higher
- ③ N.B No language requirements imposed to the applicants whose native language or second language is English.

2) Interview score is 60 points out of 100 or higher

- Unsuccessful applicants are;
 - ① those whose interview score is less than 60;
 - ② those who do not meet the admission requirements.

4. Application fee (KRW 60,000 KRW) should be remitted to BUFS bank account within the first week of semester.
